## ITINERARY

**Day 1: Home City ~ Warther's Carvings ~ Amish Dinner & Show:** Travel aboard a deluxe highway touring motorcoach into the heart of Ohio's Amish country. As we travel rest and meal stops will be made periodically. By early afternoon we arrive at Warther's Carvings, Gardens and Knife Shop for an amazing tour of the priceless works of World's Master Carver, Mooney Warther. Tour the button house with over 70,000 buttons arranged in artwork, stroll the beautiful Swiss gardens and visit the family cutlery factory and gift shop. Later today we arrive at our hotel for a delightful two-night stay. This evening we enjoy dinner followed by the show, Confession.

**Day 2: Longaberger Basket Factory & Homestead ~ Baltic Mill ~ Sugarcreek:** Following breakfast embark on a scenic ride to Longaberger Basket Factory & Homestead. A guided tour of the factory provides the opportunity to watch weavers create over 40,000 baskets per day. Ample time will be allotted for shopping and lunch on own. This afternoon we visit Baltic Mill, an old fashioned grist mill which grinds their own cornmeal, flour, pancake and bread machine mixes. Later today we visit Sugarcreek, known as "Little Switzerland of Ohio" because of its Swiss settlers and architecture. Continue on to Walnut Creek for an ice cream break. Choose from over 30 varieties featuring homemade custard. This evening we gather for dinner at an Amish home for a wedding style feast.

**Day 3: Guggisberg Cheese ~ Miller Bakery & Country Store ~ Flea Market ~ Journey Home:** After breakfast we visit Guggisberg Cheese, home of the original baby swiss. Next, stop at Miller Bakery & Country Store, an old order Amish establishment featuring fresh baked goods, jams, jellies, pickles, homemade candy and crafts. Later this morning enjoy free time to stroll the Flea Market which features over 400 vendors under roof. Following a lunch break we depart Holmes County and begin our journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically.
