ITINERARY

Day 1: Home ~ White Mountains ~ Lincoln, New Hampshire: Travel aboard a deluxe motorcoach across New York, Vermont and into New Hampshire. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically as we travel. Later today we arrive in the Lincoln area for a memorable four-night stay. Gather for dinner this evening at a local restaurant.

Day 2: Lake Winnepesaukee Cruise ~ Wolfeboro ~ Wright Museum of WWII ~ Indian Head Resort: This morning we motor into the heart of the White Mountains of New Hampshire. Travel to Weirs Beach and board the M/S Mount Washington for a delightful cruise across Lake Winnepesaukee. Enjoy free time for lunch, shopping and sightseeing in the quaint town of Wolfeboro. This afternoon enjoy stops at Wright Museum of WWII and Moultonborough Old Country Store. Gather for dinner at the Indian Head Resort before returning to our hotel for the night.

Day 3: Mount Washington Cog Railway ~ Kancamagus Highway: This morning following breakfast we travel to Bretton Woods and board the Mount Washington Cog Railway for a spectacular ride to the top of Mount Washington. The Cog is the world's first mountain-climbing cog railway. Ride to the 6288' summit of Mount Washington—the highest mountain peak in the Northeast! Enjoy time to explore the State Park at the summit. Later this afternoon we travel along the scenic Kancamagus Highway, recognized as one of the most picturesque drives in New England.

Day 4: Bath, NH ~ Mount Washington Hotel ~ Café Lafayette Dinner Train: Today we journey to the quaint town of Bath and visit Brick General Store dating from 1790. Following a lunch break we arrive at the historic Mount Washington Hotel. Enjoy a guided tour of this magnificent landmark followed by a New England Cider Social. Later this afternoon we return to Lincoln and board the Café Lafayette Dinner Train for a wonderful railway dining experience. Return to our hotel for the final night.

Day 5: Canterbury Shaker Village ~ Journey Home: This morning following breakfast we travel south to Canterbury, NH for a visit to Canterbury Shaker Village. Declared a National Historic Landmark in 1993, Canterbury is one of the most intact and authentic surviving Shaker sites. Later today we begin our journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically.
