

Lincoln Remembrance in DC

On the 145th anniversary of his assassination

We depart at 8am aboard a private touring motorcoach for Washington, DC and a special day of remembrance of Abraham Lincoln, our 16th President of the United States. 2009 was the bicentennial of his birth. Our first stop is **Ford's Theatre**, the site of Lincoln's assassination. *Our visit will be on the 145th anniversary of that infamous day in 1865!* We will see Richard Helleesen's one-act play **One Destiny**. The play revisits April 14, 1865, and the events surrounding the tragic assassination of Abraham Lincoln through the eyes of two men who were there when history happened. We will also visit the **theatre's museum** and the **Peterson House**, where Lincoln passed away the morning after the shooting.

Later today enjoy a **delicious group lunch** on the Washington Harbor in Georgetown overlooking the Potomac River.

Next we will visit **St. John's Episcopal Church**. Established in 1815, it stands opposite the White House on the north side of Lafayette Square. The parish was organized to serve as a church for occupants of the White House and their families. Every Chief Executive since James Madison, the nation's 4th President, has attended regular or occasional services. Hence, St. John's has become known as the "Church of the Presidents" and Pew 54 is the traditional President's Pew. Lincoln regularly attended the church but he normally sat in Pew 89, the last row in the corner next to the door.

We will continue our day with a **bus tour of Our Nation's Capital** that will culminate with a visit to the **Lincoln Memorial**, our nation's tribute to one of our greatest leaders. Later we will depart Washington DC and begin our journey back to Hagerstown with a 6pm arrival.
