**Day 1: Home City ~ Our Lady of Victory Basilica ~ Niagara Falls** Travel aboard a deluxe highway touring motorcoach to the Niagara Falls area. Stop in Lackawanna, NY at **Our Lady of Victory Basilica and National Shrine**. The Basilica stands as a reflection of the life and work of Fr. Henry Baker who, through the intercession of Mary, saved thousands of orphaned and troubled boys and provided aid to multitudes of adults in hard economic times. Continue on to Niagara Falls for the night. **Niagara Falls** has never ceased to be a natural wonder, mesmerizing travelers from around the world.

**Day 2: Niagara Falls ~ Toronto, Ontario ~ VIA Rail ~ Montreal, Quebec** This morning we travel to **Toronto** and embark on a **guided tour** of this fascinating and multicultural city. Highlights include City Hall, Nathan Phillips Square, CN Tower, Chinatown and Harbourfront Centre. Stop at historic St. Paul Church and celebrate Mass. Later today climb aboard VIA Rail's sleek, comfortable, high-speed LRC train for an **exciting ride to Montreal**. Enjoy plush reclining seats and large observation windows as we travel north into southern Quebec. Later this afternoon arrive in Montreal for the night.

**Day 3: Old Montreal ~ Basilica of Notre Dame ~ St. Joseph's Oratory ~ Cap de la Madeleine** Located between the St. Lawrence River and the city centre, Old Montreal and the Old Port reveal a great city which began back in 1642. Visit one of the most magnificent French-Canadian churches and one of the largest churches in North America, the **Basilica of Notre Dame**. Renowned for its opulent deco, the Gothic Revival Notre Dame Basilica features spectacular stained glass windows depicting religious scenes and the history of the original parish. Continue on to one of the world's largest basilicas and one of Montreal's most important religious shrines, **St. Joseph's Oratory**. The basilica was the dream of Blessed Brother Andre, a Holy Cross monk known as a healer, invoking cures for hundreds through the Blessed Brother Andre, a Holy Cross monk known as a healer, invoking cures for hundreds through the intercessory prayer of his patron saint, St. Joseph. Later today we leave Montreal and travel north along a picturesque route following the mighty St. Lawrence Seaway to **Cap de la Madeleine** for a delightful three-night stay.

**Day 4: Our Lady of the Cape Shrine: The Shrine of Notre Dame du Cap** is Canada's national shrine to Mary and attracts thousands of pilgrims every year. Located next to the St. Lawrence River, the Shrine and its setting offer a unique haven of peace. The Basilica of Notre Dame du Cap, built in 1714, is a striking stone octagonal structure that accommodates over 2,000 people. Located within the chapel is the miraculous Madonna of Notre Dame du Cap statue, which in 1888, became momentarily animated. Enjoy a relaxing and inspiring day of pilgrimage at this beautiful shrine. Mass, confessions, various devotions and evening candlelight procession will be available.

**Day 5: Basilica of Ste-Anne-de-Baupre ~ Alabert Gilles Copper Art Museum ~ Quebec City:** This morning journey along the north shore of the St. Lawrence River to Ste-Anne-de-Baupre. Visit the **Basilica of Ste-Anne-de-Baupre**, a world-famous shrine that annually attracts more than a million pilgrims and visitors and has been the site of countless miraculous cures since the first chapel was built in 1658. Later today, we stop at **Albert Gilles Copper Art Museum**. The museum features multiple creations in embossed or enameled copper. Later this afternoon enjoy free time for shopping and dinner on your own in **old Quebec City**. Visit the many boutiques, galleries and shops of Old Quebec. Items such as antiques, leather goods, Eskimo and Indian art, books and native handicrafts are for sale. Take a relaxing stroll along Dufferin Terrace for a lovely view of Old Lower Town and the St. Lawrence. Later this evening we travel back to Cap de la Madeleine.

**Day 6: Cap de la Madeleine ~ Shrine of Our Lady of LaSalette:** Following **breakfast** we will leave Canada to begin our journey home. This afternoon we will visit the **Shrine of Our Lady of LaSalette** in Enfield, NH. The shrine gives active witness to the mandate of Mary at LaSalette to respond to the spiritual needs of the pilgrim People of God. LaSalette Shrine is located on the shores of Lake Mascoma, and early settlers to the area called this patch of heaven "Chosen Vale". Mascoma's blue waters mirror the birch, pine, and maple that populate the surrounding hills and mountains and give this valley a unique beauty the year 'round. It is no surprise that the spirit jumps into prayer once arrived. Besides the chapel, pilgrims may meditate at the facsimile of the Apparition, the Rosary Walk, the Peace Walk, Mary's Garden, or anywhere on the Shrine's 70+ acre property. Later today we arrive in our hotel for the night in the Springfield, MA area.

**Day 7: National Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa ~ Journey Home:** Following **breakfast** we will continue our journey home. This afternoon we will visit the **National Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa**. Built in 1966 in commemoration of 1000 years of the Catholic church in Poland, this beautiful Marian shrine sits atop Beacon Hill in Doylestown, PA. Later this afternoon we leave the shrine and continue our journey home.
