

Thunder Bay Resort & Michigan Advenshore

Day 1: Home City ~ Thunder Bay Resort ~ Northern Michigan: Travel aboard a deluxe highway touring motorcoach to Northern Michigan. As we travel rest and meal stops will be made periodically.
