Day 1: Home City ~ National Blue Army Shrine of the Immaculate Heart of Mary ~ Bethlehem, PA: Travel aboard a deluxe highway coach to New Jersey. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. After lunch we will arrive at **The National Blue Army Shrine of the Immaculate Heart of Mary** to honor the 92nd anniversary of the sixth apparition of Our Lady at Fatima. Located on 150 beautifully landscaped acres in the hills of Warren County in Washington, NJ, the Shrine offers all who come here a peaceful setting for prayer and meditation. The special charisma of the Shrine is peace, and a unique closeness to Jesus and Mary is experienced by pilgrims who come with faith, love and devotion to honor the Eucharistic Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of His Mother. While visiting the Shrine you can walk through the beautiful Rosary Garden, where each of the Mysteries are represented in a unique and appropriate setting that will add a new spiritual dimension to your prayer and meditation. Also visit the Holy House Chapel, an exact replica of the Holy House of Loreto, where Jesus, Mary and Joseph lived, and view the relics that include a branch from the original holmoak tree. Sister Lucia's vision of the Holy Trinity ("the Last Vision of Fatima" at Tuy, Spain) is depicted in statuary. Later today we will travel to Bethlehem, PA for an overnight stay. Gather this evening for a **group dinner**.

Day 2: National Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe ~ Padre Pio Centre ~ Blessed Sacrament Parish ~ Journey Home: This morning after **breakfast** we arrive in Allentown and visit historic Immaculate Conception Church. Founded by Saint John Neumann in 1857, the church now houses the **National Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe**. The shrine features a reproduction of Our Lady of Guadalupe that is striking similar to the original in Mexico. Later we will travel on the '**Road to Emmaus**' to nearby Bally, PA for **Mass** at **Most Blessed Sacrament Parish**. Established in 1741, it is one of the oldest Catholic churches in Pennsylvania. After **lunch** at a local restaurant, we will visit the **National Centre for Padre Pio and Museum**. Nestled on 50 beautiful acres in rural Pennsylvania, the National Centre of St. Padre Pio is the only information center in North America officially authorized by and working with St. Padre Pio's Friars of San Giovanni Rotonda, Italy. A replica of the original Friary church where St. Padre Pio received his stigmata is also on the grounds. In the museum visitors will be transported to an inside glimpse of the life of Padre Pio, the Italian monk who was canonized as a saint in June, 2002. The 21,000 square foot facility contains replicas of seven different buildings in Italy representing significant phases in the life of Saint Pio. Each setting is exact in its measurements of the original locations as well as the materials, finishes and furnishings. The museum contains the greatest display of personal belongings of Saint Pio outside of Italy. We will arrive home at approximately 6pm to complete our grace-filled pilgrimage.
