## ITINERARY

**Day 1: Buffalo ~ Indianapolis, Indiana**

Travel aboard a deluxe highway touring motorcoach leaving from Buffalo to Indianapolis. En route rest and meal stops will be made periodically. This evening we gather for a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. Enjoy the night stay in the Indianapolis area.

**Day 2: Indianapolis ~ Ozark Mountains ~ Branson, Missouri ~ Hughes Brothers**

This morning following breakfast we continue traveling on to Branson. Later today we arrive in Branson for a delightful four-night stay. Located in the heart of the Ozark Mountains, Branson is where Nashville meets Las Vegas with a spectacular menu of fabulous shows. Over the years Branson has been transformed from a sleepy fishing village to one of the country's major entertainment centers. This evening following dinner enjoy reserved seating at the Hughes Brothers Show.

**Day 3: College of the Ozarks ~ Historic Branson ~ Shoji Tabuchi Show**

This morning we enjoy a guided tour through the College of the Ozarks. This small liberal arts school is principally staffed and maintained by its students who then receive discounts off room, board and tuition. Enjoy free time in historic downtown Branson for lunch and shopping on own. Gather this evening for dinner before a wonderful evening of entertainment with Shoji Tabuchi. Known as the "King of Branson," Shoji's dazzling shows have turned country and western fans colorblind.

**Day 4: The Brett Family Show ~ Grand Village ~ Stone Hill Winery ~ Twelve Irish Tenors**

This morning we transfer to The American Bandstand Theater for reserved seating with the Brett Family Show. Enjoy a lunch break at Grand Village which features 50 specialty shops and eateries. This afternoon we visit Stone Hill Winery and see how cream sherry and spumante are made. Later today we gather for dinner at a local restaurant and then enjoy a delightful evening of entertainment with the Twelve Irish Tenors.

**Day 5: IMAX Theater ~ Showboat Branson Belle ~ Acrobats of China**

This morning we are introduced to the history, heritage and spirit of the Ozarks with Branson's exclusive IMAX film, "Ozarks Legacy & Legend," at Branson's IMAX Entertainment Complex. Later today board the lovely Showboat Branson Belle paddle wheeler for a delightful luncheon cruise featuring the Funny Fiddle Show. This evening enjoy reserved seating at one of Branson's most popular venues, the Acrobats of China. The New Shanghai Circus is a spectacular extravaganza of elegant eastern dance, dazzling acrobatics, mysterious magic and mystical music.

**Day 6: Branson ~ St. Louis ~ Mississippi River ~ Gateway Arch ~ Indianapolis**

Today we leave Branson and travel to St. Louis. Enjoy a stop at the Gateway Arch – a inverted catenary of gleaming stainless steel soaring 630 feet above the shoreline of the great Mississippi River. Visit the Museum of Westward Expansion which features an extensive collection of artifacts related to the Lewis & Clark expedition. Later today we continue east to Indianapolis for dinner and the final night.
