### **Day 1: Home City ~ Hartford, Connecticut**

Travel aboard a deluxe highway motorcoach to the Hartford area for the first overnight. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Gather for dinner at a local restaurant.

### **Day 2: Hartford ~ Boston ~ Plymouth ~ Hyannis, Cape Cod**

This morning following breakfast we travel to Boston, Massachusetts – the “Cradle of Liberty”. Enjoy a guided sightseeing tour of this historical and fascinating city. Follow the Freedom Trail of Paul Revere and see Bunker Hill Monument, *U.S.S. Constitution*, Faneuil Hall, Old North Church and Back Bay. Afterwards, travel to Plymouth Rock and see the Mayflower II. Later this afternoon travel to Hyannis on Cape Cod for a delightful three-night stay. Cape Cod evokes images of weathered - shingled cottages, sea grass-sprayed dunes and wind chiseled sea captains, all waiting to enchant you! Gather for dinner at a local restaurant.

### **Day 3: JFK Memorial ~ Cape Cod National Seashore ~ Provincetown**

Following breakfast we explore the length of Cape Cod to Provincetown. Begin in Hyannis and see St. Francis Xavier Church, (attended by the Kennedy family), the Kennedy Memorial and Hyannisport. Travel down the Old King’s Highway past cranberry bogs, golden salt marshes and panoramic views of Cape Cod Bay. Continue along Cape Cod National Seashore to Provincetown located at the tip of Cape Cod. Provincetown was the first landing place of the Pilgrims. Today it is a bustling artists’ haven filled with a variety of curiosity shops and boutiques. There will be free time for browsing on your own in the downtown area. Overnight Cape Cod.

### **Day 4: Cape Cod ~ Martha’s Vineyard**

This morning following breakfast we board a ferry and sail to the charming island of Martha’s Vineyard. As with Nantucket, Martha’s Vineyard was an early whaling village. Edgartown is the island’s oldest European settlement. Continue on to Oak Bluffs which features carpenter gothic cottages and a quaint shopping district. Uncover local treasures in independent eclectic shops. Walk along the beaches that have made this island a popular resort area. Later today we return to the cape for a group dinner and overnight.

### **Day 5: Cape Cod ~ Newport, Rhode Island ~ Foxwoods Casino**

Today after breakfast we leave Cape Cod and head for beautiful Newport, Rhode Island, one of New England’s most famous ports. Newport is known for its opulent resort section of magnificent estates. Drive along the spectacular Ten Mile Drive to view the summer playground of our country’s first millionaires. Visit one of Newport’s most splendid mansions, the Breakers - summer house of Cornelius Vanderbilt. Enjoy lunch on your own in the brick marketplace of Newport’s harbor before continuing to Connecticut. Enjoy the evening at Foxwoods Casino. Dinner is included this evening. Overnight Connecticut.

### **Day 6: Foxwoods ~ Mystic Seaport ~ Journey Home**

Breakfast included. This morning we visit the Mystic Seaport Museum, a fascinating complex which features historic homes, shops, and trade buildings that promote an understanding of life in a seaport in the 1800’s. More than 100 ships and boats are on display. Later this afternoon we depart for a scenic journey back to Ohio. Rest and meal stops will be made.
