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Day 1: Home City ~ Fishkill, New York

Travel aboard a deluxe highway motorcoach to Fishkill for first overnight. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Tonight, enjoy a “welcome-to-the-tour” dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 2: Fishkill, New York ~ Salem

Following breakfast travel to Salem, Massachusetts. Upon arrival visit the House of Seven Gables and the Salem Witch Museum. The House of Seven Gables was made famous by the American author Nathaniel Hawthorne for his book of the same name. The Salem Witch Museum features life-size stage sets, exhibits & a guided tour exploring the 1692 Salem witch trials, plus witchcraft today. Later today enjoy free time on Pickering Wharf. Overnight in the Salem area.

Day 3: Boston ~ Plymouth ~ Hyannis, Cape Cod

This morning following breakfast we explore Boston, Massachusetts – the “Cradle of Liberty”. Enjoy a guided sightseeing tour of this historical and fascinating city. Follow the Freedom Trail of Paul Revere and see Bunker Hill Monument, U.S.S. Constitution, Faneuil Hall, Old North Church and Back Bay. Afterwards, travel to Plymouth Rock and see the Mayflower II. Later this afternoon travel to Cape Cod for a delightful three-night stay. Ah, Cape Cod! The very words evoke images of weathered - shingled cottages, sea grass-sprayed dunes and wind chiseled sea captains, all waiting to enchant you! Our hotel is located right next to the ocean!

Day 4: JFK Memorial ~ Cape Cod National Seashore ~ Provincetown

Following breakfast we explore the length of Cape Cod to Provincetown. Begin the day in Hyannis and stop at the JFK Memorial. Travel down the Old King’s Highway past cranberry bogs, golden salt marshes and panoramic views of Cape Cod Bay. Continue along Cape Cod National Seashore to Provincetown located at the tip of Cape Cod. Provincetown was the first landing place of the Pilgrims. Today it is a bustling artists’ haven filled with a variety of curiosity shops and boutiques. There will be free time for browsing on your own in the downtown area plus free time to explore the beachfront next to our hotel.

Day 5: Cape Cod ~ Martha’s Vineyard

This morning we board a ferry and sail to the charming island of Martha’s Vineyard. As with Nantucket, Martha’s Vineyard was an early whaling village. Edgartown is the island’s oldest European settlement. Continue on to Oak Bluffs which features carpenter gothic cottages and a quaint shopping district. Uncover local treasures in independent eclectic shops. Walk along the beaches that have made this island a popular resort area. Later today we return to Hyannis for dinner.

Day 6: Cape Cod ~ Newport, Rhode Island ~ Foxwoods Resort & Casino

Today, leave Cape Cod and head for beautiful Newport, Rhode Island, one of New England’s most famous ports. Newport is known for its opulent resort section of magnificent estates. Drive along the spectacular Ten Mile Drive to view the summer playground of our country’s first millionaires. Visit one of Newport’s most splendid mansions, the Breakers - summer house of Cornelius Vanderbilt. Enjoy lunch on your own in the brick marketplace of Newport’s harbor before continuing to Connecticut. Enjoy the evening and overnight at Foxwoods Resort & Casino. A festive dinner buffet is included at the resort.

Day 7: Mystic Seaport Museum ~ Poconos Mountains

Breakfast included. This morning we visit the Mystic Seaport Museum, a fascinating complex which features historic homes, shops, and trade buildings that promote an understanding of life in a seaport in the 1800’s. More than 100 ships and boats are on display. Later this afternoon enjoy a scenic ride into the Pocono Mountain region of Pennsylvania. Gather this evening for a special “farewell” dinner. Overnight in the Poconos.

Day 8: Poconos ~ Journey Home

Following breakfast we depart the Poconos for a scenic journey back to Ohio. Rest and meal stops will be made. An early evening arrival is expected with fond memories of seeing New England in style!
