

Day 1: Home City ~ Cape Liberty, New Jersey: Depart aboard a highway coach for Cape Liberty. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Later today we board the Adventure of the Seas and embark on a memorable six-night cruise to New England and Maritimes of Canada.

Day 2: Cruising at Sea: Enjoy the day cruising to Bar Harbor, Maine. The Adventure of the Seas is one of five Royal Caribbean Cruise Lines Voyager Class. This 3,000-passenger vessel includes 15 decks and offers all the amenities and features of a full-service cruise ship.

Day 3: Bar Harbor, Maine: Our first port-of-call is lovely Bar Harbor. The beauty of sea, mountain, lake and forest made this region the summer playground for America's wealthy during the early 20th-century. Enjoy the day in Bar Harbor which features numerous specialty shops, charming boutiques and wonderful restaurants. No visit to Maine would be complete without a guided tour of its crown jewel, Acadia National Park. Acadia features an array of stunning landscapes ranging from sandy beaches, a rare sight along Maine's rocky northern coast, to Cadillac Mountain, the highest point on the eastern coastline of North America.

Days 4: Saint John, New Brunswick: This morning we dock at Saint John, located on the famous Bay of Fundy. Visit towering Hopewell Rocks or Reversing Falls where Saint John River's flow is thrust back upstream by the ocean's whirling rapids. Visit one of the oldest museums in Canada, Saint John's New Brunswick Museum, to see Canadian and International art and Hall of Great Whales. Don't miss the city's National Historic Sites: Loyalist House and Carleton Martello Tower. Enjoy lunch at Saint John's City Market which features local culinary delights like lobster rolls and bacon-wrapped scallops.

Day 5: Halifax, Nova Scotia: Enjoy the day in the beautiful provincial capital city of Halifax. Stroll the scenic waterfront area which features wonderful shops, restaurants and attractions. Visit the citadel, a large star-shaped masonry fort built in 1828. Local harbor cruises offer visitors the opportunity to see marine wildlife including majestic whales. Take the Halifax Connection tour and visit Fairview Lawn Cemetery and the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic both of which feature artifacts and history on the Titanic. Journey along the beautiful South Shore to Peggy's Cove. An old lighthouse perched on a massive granite ledge and fishing boats moored along weatherworn wharves create the ideal atmosphere for artists and photographers.

Day 6: Cruising at Sea: Enjoy the day at sea aboard the Adventure of the Seas.

Day 7: Cape Liberty, NJ ~ Journey Home: Today the Adventure of the Seas returns to Cape Liberty. Following disembarkation board our coach for the journey home.
