Travel aboard a deluxe highway coach to Dayton, Ohio. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Later today we arrive in Dayton and to the National Museum of the United States Air Force. Enjoy the afternoon exploring one of the most impressive attractions in the country. The National Museum of the United States Air Force collects, researches, conserves, interprets and presents the Air Force's history, heritage and traditions, as well as today's mission to fly, fight and win ... in Air, Space and Cyberspace to a global audience through engaging exhibits, educational outreach, special programs, and the stewardship of the national historic collection. Later today we gather for dinner at a local restaurant and then proceed to our hotel for the night. The following morning after breakfast we visit Carillon Historical Park. In 1950, Carillon Historical Park's museum complex opened with the purpose of showcasing the region's industrial innovations, transportation achievements, and Dayton's contributions to world progress. Since construction first began on Deeds Carillon in 1940, the dreams of Edith and Edward Deeds have evolved into a beautiful 65-acre campus—designed by the Olmsted Brothers (the famed landscape architects responsible for Central Park)—containing dozens of museum buildings and countless artifacts. The Dayton region's remarkable story continues to inspire visitors from around the world. Later today we begin our journey home.
