## ITINERARY

- Day 1:** Depart aboard a deluxe highway touring motorcoach and travel south through Pennsylvania and Maryland en route to the Washington, D.C. area. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Upon arrival in the DC area gather for a group welcome dinner at a local restaurant. Later this evening we arrive at our hotel in College Park, Maryland for a delightful three-night stay.
- Day 2:** This morning after breakfast at the hotel we depart on a scenic guided tour of Washington, D.C.'s monuments and memorials. Each spring DC showcases 3,000 cherry trees with their vibrant pale pink and white flowers. During our tour stops will be made at the World War II War Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Memorial, and Vietnam War Memorial. Additional sights will also include the U.S. Capitol, White House, Washington Monument, Jefferson Memorial and the Tidal Basin area. Enjoy free time for lunch and sightseeing on own at one of several Smithsonian museums. Choose from the National Museum of American History, National Air & Space Museum or National Museum of Natural History. This evening we board the lovely Odyssey for a delightful dinner cruise on the Potomac River.
- Day 3:** Following breakfast, depart the hotel and travel to Arlington National Cemetery. Enjoy a narrated tram tour which includes stops at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the gravesites of John F. Kennedy and Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis. Following a lunch break enjoy a guided tour at Washington National Cathedral. Completed in 1990, after 83 years of construction, this impressive Gothic cathedral is the sixth largest in the world. Notable individuals interred in the cathedral are President Woodrow Wilson, Helen Keller and Adm. George Dewey. This evening after a dinner break embark on a memorable illumination drive through DC. Return to our hotel for the final overnight.
- Day 4:** Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and then depart for Annapolis, capital city of Maryland and one of the oldest cities in the country. Enjoy a guided tour of the United States Naval Academy. Established in 1845 the academy is the undergraduate college of the United States Navy. Enjoy free time for lunch and shopping in the historic district of Annapolis. Later today we depart Annapolis and begin our journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically.
