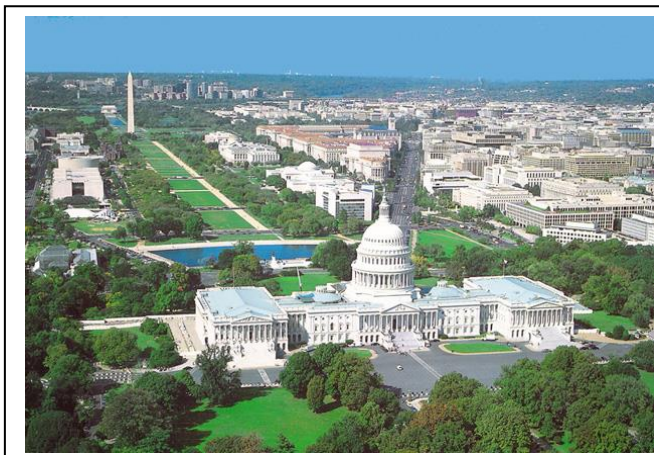

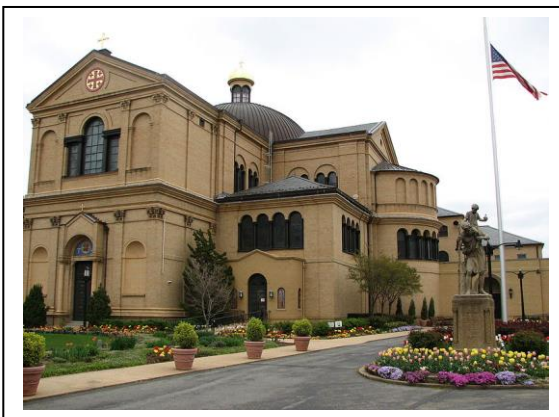
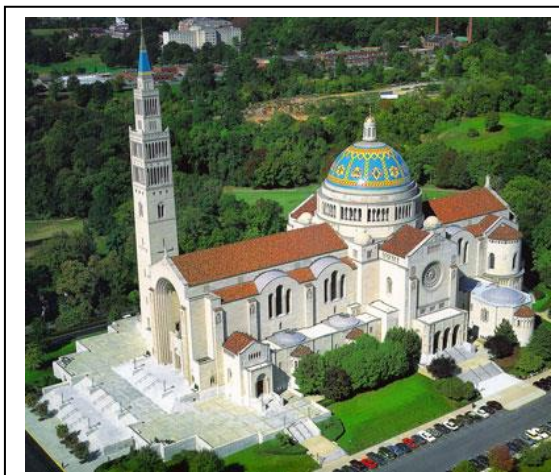

Day 1: Home City ~ Washington, D.C. ~ Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception ~ Franciscan Monastery & Gardens: Depart aboard a deluxe highway touring motorcoach for our nation's capital. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. By early afternoon we arrive in the Washington, D.C area and to the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. This basilica, which is the largest church in the Americas and the eighth largest in the world, tells the story of the faith of countless generations of American Catholics whose descendants brought their heritage of Christianity to America on the waves of immigration. The National Shrine is a marvelous place of prayer and pilgrimage. Enjoy a guided tour of the basilica followed by a private group Mass. Later today enjoy a stop at Franciscan Monastery and Gardens. The church and grounds contain replicas of the principal Shrines and Chapels found in the Holy Land; the main Shrine being a replica of the Holy Sepulcher of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Gather this evening for dinner at a local restaurant and then transfer to our hotel for a delightful two-night stay.

Day 2: Monuments & Memorials ~ Holocaust Museum ~ Illumination Drive: This morning we embark on a guided sightseeing tour through Washington, D.C. Begin at Capitol Hill to see the U.S. Capitol. Travel down Constitution Avenue along the Mall past the Washington Monument, Smithsonian Museums, various embassies and the White House. Scheduled stops will be made at Lincoln Memorial, Korea War Memorial, Vietnam War Memorial, Franklin D. Roosevelt Memorial and the World War II War Memorial. Enjoy free time for lunch and shopping at historic Union Station. Later this afternoon we visit the Holocaust Museum which presents the history of the six million Jews and millions of others who suffered and died at the hands of the Nazis during World War II. This evening enjoy dinner at a local restaurant followed by an illumination drive of DC.

Day 3: Baltimore ~ Basilica of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary ~ Inner Harbor ~ Journey Home: Today we head north to Baltimore. Rich in Catholic history, Baltimore is home to the first Catholic cathedral, first seminary and the first parochial school. Enjoy a guided tour and Mass at the Basilica of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the nation's oldest Catholic cathedral. The Basilica is where most of the first bishops in the United States were ordained and was once considered the most beautiful church in America. Later today enjoy free time for lunch and shopping at the Inner Harbor. Once home to decaying factories and warehouses, the harbor is now a showplace of gleaming office buildings and the glass-enclosed pavilions of Harborplace which rise from the water's edge. Later today we depart Baltimore and begin our journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made en route.
