

# *Historic Marietta, Ohio*

Depart aboard a private motorcoach and travel to historic Marietta. In 1788, Pioneers of the Ohio Company made Marietta the first permanent settlement in the Northwest Territory. Today we will discover this picturesque riverboat town, where the past peacefully resides with the present. Upon arrival visit the lovely Basilica of St. Mary which was recently restored to its original magnificence. Founded in 1838, St. Mary's houses a series of outstanding stained-glass windows which came from Munich, Germany. Later this morning enjoy a guided city tour of Marietta highlighting beautiful Victorian homes, Marietta College, Meig's House, and ancient Indian mounds and earthworks. Gather for a delicious group luncheon at a local restaurant. Following lunch enjoy free time for shopping, browsing or relaxing in Marietta's quaint historic district. This lovely area of the city features brick streets, charming lampposts and a collection of shops offering antiques, vintage clothing, collectibles, fine jewelry, novelties and books. Later today we embark on a delightful sightseeing cruise along the Muskingum and Ohio rivers aboard the 300-passenger *Valley Gem* sternwheeler. Following our cruise we leave Marietta and begin our journey home.
