ITINERARY

Day 1: Home City ~ Lancaster, PA ~ Best Western Eden Resort ~ Magic & Wonder Dinner Theater: Depart aboard a deluxe highway coach for Lancaster County, PA. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Later today we arrive in Lancaster for a memorable two-night stay at the lovely Best Western Eden Resort. Gather for dinner and entertainment at the Magic & Wonder Dinner Theater. Go as far as imagination can take you in this amazing variety magic show!
