



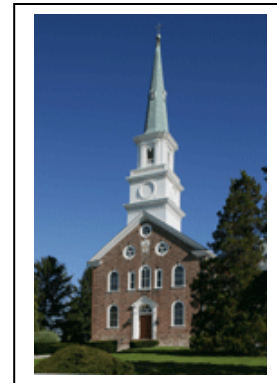

ITINERARY

Day 1: Lancaster, PA ~ Historic St. Mary Church ~ Sight & Sound Theater's JOSHUA:

Depart aboard a deluxe highway coach for Lancaster County, PA. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Later this morning we arrive in downtown Lancaster City and to lovely St. Mary Catholic Church. Established in 1741, this beautiful church has the distinguished honor of being the fourth oldest Catholic Church in the original thirteen colonies. The church was granted a special spiritual bond with the Papal Basilica of St. Mary Major in Rome on February 5, 2009, and with it comes the privilege of a Plenary Indulgence for each member of the faithful who makes a pilgrimage to the church under certain prescribed conditions. After a lunch break we enjoy reserved seating at the beautiful Sight & Sound Millennium Theatre for the all-new production JOSHUA. From the banks of the Jordan River to the towering walls of Jericho, JOSHUA is a miraculous adventure for the whole family. Journey alongside the people of Israel as they navigate their new-found freedom in an unforgiving wilderness. When Joshua is called to replace Moses as their faithful leader, tensions mount during dwindling supplies and approaching armies. With one last fortified city standing between the Israelites and the Promised Land, unexpected help emerges from behind enemy lines and Joshua's trust in God's plan is put to the ultimate test. Experience one of the most redemptive stories of the Bible as it comes to life in this brand-new original stage production from Sight & Sound Theatres. Following the show gather for a delicious Pennsylvania Dutch dinner. Transfer to our nearby hotel for the night.

Day 2: Basilica of the Sacred Heart of Jesus ~ Gettysburg Battlefield & Visitor Center:

This morning, following breakfast, we depart Lancaster County and travel west to Irishtown for a stop at the Basilica of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Built in 1787, the Basilica of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is the oldest Catholic Church building in the United States built of stone, and the first parish church in America dedicated to the loving heart of our divine savior. Referred to in colonial times as Conewago Chapel, this beautiful church became the headquarters of the Jesuit missionaries of the St. Francis Regis mission circuit. Prince Gallitzin spent his first years in the priesthood here and St. John Neumann visited Conewago on five occasions. Continue to Gettysburg for a lunch break followed by a visit to the Gettysburg National Visitor Center & Museum. The facility houses one of the world's largest American Civil War collections with over 38,000 artifacts and 350,000 printed documents and photographs. Enjoy a narrated presentation in the Gettysburg Cyclorama. Later this afternoon we embark on a guided tour of the Gettysburg Battlefield, where one of the most important and hotly contested battles of the Civil War was fought July 1-3, 1863. Throughout the park there are over 1,300 monuments, statues and markers, three observation towers and 31 miles of marked avenues. Additional highlights include Gettysburg National Cemetery, Eternal Light Peace Memorial and Devil's Den. Later this afternoon we begin our journey home.
