ITINERARY

Day 1: Home City ~ Midland, Michigan ~ Dow Gardens: Travel aboard a touring motorcoach to the Midland area for the first night. Rest and meal stops will be made en route. Later this afternoon enjoy time to stroll through Dow Gardens. Gather for a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Midland.

Day 2: Alden B. Dow Home & Studio ~ Cross in the Woods ~ Mackinac Island: After breakfast we visit Alden B. Dow Home and Studio. His own Home and Studio located in Midland, Michigan, exemplifies how this incredible architect masterfully weaves structure and nature together for the ultimate living environment. Gather for a group luncheon at a local restaurant and then head north to Mackinac Island. En route a stop will be made at the massive Cross in the Woods. Later this afternoon we board a ferry in St. Ignace and sail across the Straits of Mackinac to charming Mackinac Island. Enjoy a delightful two-night stay at the Lake View Hotel, located along the main street in town.

Day 3: Mackinac Island Carriage Tour ~ Grand Hotel ~ Mackinac Island at leisure: This morning after breakfast we explore beautiful Mackinac Island. The island is only three miles long and two miles wide with a rugged shoreline. Besides a fire truck, ambulance and public utility truck, no motor vehicles are permitted on the island. Embark on a scenic horse-drawn carriage ride around the island. Historical highlights include Fort Mackinac, Arch Rock, Skull Cave, Governor's Mansion and Surry Hill. End our tour at the beautiful Grand Hotel where we are treated to the fabulous luncheon buffet. Glimmering like a diamond on an island of brilliant green, Grand Hotel beckons you to a bygone era of old-world hospitality and charm. Later today we return to our hotel and enjoy the balance of the day at leisure. Stroll through town and enjoy the many shops, boutiques and restaurants.

Day 4: Mackinac Island ~ Grand Rapids ~ Frederick Meijer Sculpture Gardens: After breakfast we return to the mainland and travel south to Grand Rapids. Enjoy time to explore Frederick Meijer Sculpture Gardens. Immerse yourself in one of the world's finest horticultural display gardens and sculpture parks. Proudly ranked among the most-visited art museums worldwide and named the Best Sculpture Park in the United States the past three years by readers of USA Today. The outstanding collection showcases over 200 captivating sculptures located within beautifully landscaped grounds, inviting you to experience the perfect blend of art and nature. Later today we gather for dinner at a local restaurant and then enjoy a two-night stay in the Grand Rapids area.

Day 5: Holland Tulip Festival ~ Windmill Island ~ Festival Parade: This morning we enjoy breakfast at our hotel and then journey to Holland. Settled by Dutch immigrants in 1847, Holland is a city steeped in history and tradition. Our visit will feature the annual Tulip Time Festival, recalling Holland's Dutch roots, with millions of tulips blooming all over the city. Tulip Time Festival has consistently been named one of the "Best Small-Town Festivals" in the country! Following a guided city tour enjoy free time for shopping, sightseeing and dinner on own in the quaint downtown area of Holland. Later this afternoon we enjoy reserved seating at one of several colorful and entertaining parades that occur during Tulip Time Festival. Later today enjoy a stop at Windmill Island. This unique attraction features canals, drawbridges, a miniature Dutch Village and a 1780's operating De Zwaan windmill brought from the Netherlands which produces a fine graham flour. Gather for dinner before returning to our hotel for the night.

Day 6: Grand Rapids ~ Journey Home: This morning after breakfast we begin our journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically.
