

## **ITINERARY**

**Day 1: Home City ~ Pittsburgh ~ Station Square ~ Gateway Clipper Cruise:** Depart by motorcoach for Pittsburgh. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically as we travel. The nation's largest inland port, Pittsburgh, famous for its Three Rivers, lies at the point where the Allegheny and Monongahela rivers meet to form the Ohio River. Enjoy free time for lunch and shopping at Station Square. Later this afternoon board the Gateway Clipper and embark on a delightful narrated river cruise featuring spectacular views of downtown Pittsburgh. Following a group dinner, travel to nearby Irwin for the overnight.

**Day 2: Amtrak's *Capitol Limited* ~ Allegheny Mountains ~ Washington, DC ~ Memorials & Monuments:** This morning after breakfast we board Amtrak's *Capitol Limited* for a delightful train ride to Washington, DC. This all-American rail excursion follows the original B&O line through the Allegheny Mountains, along the scenic Youghiogheny River, across western Maryland and into the beautiful Potomac Valley. Enjoy spectacular views that can only be seen by train. Travel aboard Amtrak's spacious Superliner equipment which features a full-service dining car and observation car. Travel through scenic Harpers Ferry, located at the confluence of the Shenandoah and Potomac rivers. By early afternoon arrive at historic Union Station and embark on a relaxing and scenic guided tour of Washington DC's monuments and memorials. Travel past Capitol Hill, White House, The Mall and Washington Monument. Stops will be made at Lincoln Memorial, Korean & Vietnam War Memorials, Franklin D. Roosevelt Memorial and the World War II War Memorial. Following our tour we gather for dinner at a local restaurant. Later this evening we arrive at our hotel for a two-night stay.

**Day 3: Arlington National Cemetery ~ Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception ~ Illumination Tour:** Following breakfast at the hotel travel to Arlington National Cemetery. Each year over Memorial Day weekend, thousands of flags mark the graves throughout the cemetery. Embark on a guided tram tour which stops at the Kennedy gravesites and the Tomb of the Unknowns for the Changing of the Guard ceremony. Following a lunch break we visit the beautiful Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. The National Shrine, which is the largest church in the America's and the eighth largest in the world, features outstanding mosaics and stained glass windows. Later today following a dinner stop embark on an evening illumination tour throughout the Washington, D.C. area.

**Day 4: Baltimore ~ Inner Harbor ~ Journey Home:** This morning we leave DC and travel to Baltimore. Enjoy free time at the Inner Harbor. Once home to decaying factories and warehouses, the harbor is now a showplace of gleaming office buildings and the glass-enclosed pavilions of Harborplace which rise from the water's edge. Later today we depart Baltimore and begin our journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically.
