Day 1: Home City ~ Spokane, Washington ~ Old Mission State Park ~ Wallace, Idaho: Begin our journey by flying scheduled air to Spokane, Washington. Travel by motorcoach into northern Idaho for a stop at Old Mission State Park. The Mission of the Sacred Heart was established in the 1850's by Catholic missionaries and members of the Coeur d'Alene Tribe. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the mission provides the opportunity to examine the dynamics and complexities between Jesuit missionaries and the tribal people among whom they settled. Enjoy dinner and lodging in Wallace.

Day 2: Wallace Sierra Silver Mine Tour ~ Kalispell, Montana: This morning after breakfast we experience the actual methods of hard-rock mining in the richest silver district on earth! Board a classic trolley for a narrated tour of historic Wallace and into a real silver mine. Following a lunch break we motor northeast into Montana, along scenic Flathead Lake and into Kalispell for a memorable two-night stay. Gather for dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 3: Glacier National Park ~ Going-to-the-Sun Road ~ Continental Divide: This morning we journey into Glacier National Park. Located in northwestern Montana, Glacier National Park features 27 glaciers, 762 lakes and some of the finest mountain scenery in America. Glacier offers snow-capped mountains, ice-sculpted valleys, bright white glaciers, sparkling lakes and waterfalls, abundant wildlife and a brilliant and diverse floral life. Embark on one of the outstanding scenic roadways of the world, Going-to-the-Sun Road. This picturesque route traverses the width of Glacier National Park, crosses the Continental Divide through Logan Pass while affording magnificent views of the park's loveliest scenery. Later today we arrive back in Kalispell for the overnight.

Day 4: Montana "Big Sky" Country ~ Yellowstone National Park: Today we leave Kalispell and journey south through Montana. The varied landscape of rolling hills, river valleys, mountain peaks, deserts and plains offer exceptional sightseeing. By late afternoon we arrive in the Yellowstone National Park area, located in the northwest corner of Wyoming. Enjoy a memorable two-night stay in West Yellowstone. Gather for dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 5: Yellowstone National Park ~ Old Faithful ~ Grand Canyon of Yellowstone: Today we explore Yellowstone National Park, the world's first national park. Established in 1872, Yellowstone features towering mountains, cascading waterfalls, abundant wildlife and the world's largest thermal basins. Our guided tour of the grand loop will incorporate the major sites and attractions of this wonderful park. Enjoy stops at the Visitors Center, Old Faithful Geyser, Mammoth Hot Springs, Yellowstone Falls and the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone. Return to West Yellowstone for the night.

Day 6: Grand Teton National Park ~ Snake River Float Trip ~ Jackson Hole, Wyoming: This morning we leave Yellowstone and head south into magnificent Grand Teton National Park. This afternoon we embark on an exciting 10-mile float trip down the Snake River. Enjoy breathtaking scenery as our experienced guide navigates the comfortable and safe rubber raft down the calm, winding river. Later today we arrive at our lodge in Jackson, Wyoming. Enjoy the evening at leisure in Jackson Hole.

Day 7: Jackson Hole at Leisure ~ Great Salt Lake ~ Salt Lake City, Utah: Following a free morning in Jackson Hole we journey south into Utah and along the Great Salt Lake to Salt Lake City. Located in a spectacular setting at the foot of the Wasatch Mountains, Salt Lake City is the cultural, ecclesiastical and political capital of Utah. Gather for dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Salt Lake.

Day 8: Salt Lake City Sights ~ Journey Home: This morning after breakfast we embark on a guided sightseeing tour of Salt Lake City. Highlights include Utah State Capitol Building, Cathedral of the Madeleine, Liberty Park, and Temple Square. Later we begin our journey home.
