

## **ITINERARY**

- Parade: Travel aboard a regularly scheduled airline to San Antonio. Often referred to as the "American Venice," San Antonio features historic architecture, sidewalk cafes and a beautiful river walk as the city's centerpiece. Enjoy a delightful four-night stay at the Holiday Inn San Antonio Riverwalk located in the heart of downtown on the famous Paseo del Rio. Gather this evening for a welcome dinner while enjoying the Texas Cavaliers River Parade on the Paseo del Rio.
- Day 2: San Antonio Sights ~ The Alamo ~ Mission San Jose ~ King William District: This morning we embark on a guided tour of San Antonio with a stop at the Alamo. Established as a mission in 1718, the Alamo was the 1836 battle sight where David Crockett, James Bowie and hundreds of men died fighting for Texas liberty against the Mexican army. Visit Mission San Jose, known as the "Queen of Missions," which features one of the finest examples of stone carving in America. Later today we travel through the lovely historic King William District and then make a stop at famous San Antonio Shoes. Enjoy the balance of the day in San Antonio at leisure.
- Day 3: <u>San Antonio at Leisure ~ Fiesta San Antonio</u>: Enjoy the day at leisure in San Antonio. Spend time shopping at the colorful Mexican Marketplace, stroll along the River Walk or enjoy the many sights and sounds of Fiesta San Antonio. The day is yours to enjoy!
- Day 4: Austin, Texas ~ Texas State Capitol ~ LBJ Library & Museum ~ Paseo del Rio Cruise: Today we travel northeast to the capital city of Austin. Our guided city tour will include a stop at the impressive sunset red granite Texas State Capitol building. Continue to the University of Texas at Austin campus and visit the Lyndon Baines Johnson Library & Museum. The complex includes papers of the Johnson presidency, sculptures of President and Mrs. Johnson, gifts from foreign heads of state and a collection of American political memorabilia. Return to San Antonio for dinner at a local restaurant followed by a memorable cruise on Paseo del Rio.
- **Day 5:** San Antonio ~ Journey Home: Today we leave San Antonio and begin our journey home.
