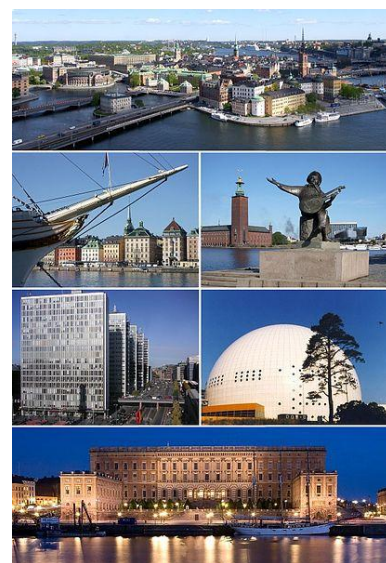

Day 1 – DEPART FOR COPENHAGEN, DENMARK

Day 2 – ARRIVE COPENHAGEN, DENMARK

Day 4 – TIVOLI GARDENS / CRUISE TO OSLO, NORWAY

Enjoy the morning and early afternoon at world famous Tivoli Gardens. Later today we embark on an exciting cruise to Oslo, Norway. On board enjoy comfortable cabins with private facilities, various dining options, live entertainment, swimming pools and saunas.

Day 5 – OSLO SIGHTS

Enjoy a scenic cruise through Oslo Fjord as we make our way into the lovely Norwegian capital. Upon arrival embark on a guided city tour. Pass the major landmarks including City Hall, National Theater, Royal Palace and Cathedral. Visit famous Frogner Park which features nearly 200 Gustav Vigeland's sculptures. Enjoy a delightful two-night stay in Oslo.

Day 6 – OSLO AT LEISURE

Enjoy the day at leisure in Oslo. As a vibrant cosmopolitan hub, Oslo offers an array of world class museums, restaurants and shops.

Day 7 – OSLO / FLAM RAILWAY / BERGEN, NORWAY

Depart Oslo and journey north into the mountainous region of Norway. Stop in the village of Flam for an unforgettable train ride on the renowned Flam Railway. Ascend 3,000 feet into Norway's mountainous glacial region for one of the most scenic views in the country. Continue on to picturesque Bergen for a wonderful two-night stay.

Day 8 – BERGEN SIGHTS

Today we explore the historic city of Bergen. Learn about the city's 11th-century origins and affiliation with the Hanseatic League. Stroll along ancient Bryggen, the iconic harborfront and visit the colorful fish market. Enjoy the balance of the day at leisure to enjoy the Gateway to the Fjords.

Day 9 – BERGEN / BALESTRAND

This morning we leave Bergen and begin a glorious journey into the heart of Norway's Fjord Region. Enjoy impressive landscapes and dramatic scenery as you pass lakes, rivers, fjords and waterfalls. Later today board a ferry for Balestrand, a romantic city on Sognefjord.

Day 10 – BALESTRAND / SOGNEFJORD CRUISE /HAMAR

Leaving Balestrand we embark on a morning sail on the green still waters of Sognefjord. Enjoy breathtaking scenery as we cruise through the longest and deepest Norwegian fjord. Later today we motor to Borgund and visit one of the early stave churches, built in 1180. Continue on to Hamar for the night.

Day 11 – HAMAR / SWEDEN LAKE REGION / STOCKHOLM

Depart to the Sweden border passing through the picturesque city of Karlstad, located between Varner Lake and Klaralven River. Continue into the lovely Lake Region of Sweden and to the capital city of Stockholm for the final two nights.

Day 12 –STOCKHOLM SIGHTS

This morning we embark on a guided city tour of Stockholm. Highlights include Old Town, the Royal Palace and the Parliament, Riddarholm Church and Gamla Stan with its labyrinth of little squares, streets and colorful buildings. Enjoy a stop at the beautiful City Hall which hosts the annual Nobel Prize Banquet. Enjoy the balance of the day at leisure.
