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## ITINERARY

### **Day 1: Home City ~ Miami-Miami Beach Sights ~ Welcome Dinner**

Fly from home city to Miami. Upon arrival in Miami embark on a delightful city tour. This thriving colorful city offers Mediterranean architecture and a contemporary skyline blended with Art Deco styling. Drive along the South Beach area which features pastel-painted hotels of flamingo pink, lime green and Caribbean blue. Stop in Little Havana which features open-air markets, shops, music and restaurants and a plaza, all of which reflect the Cuban culture. Our home for the next two nights will be in the Miami Beach area. Gather this evening at a local restaurant for a welcome dinner.

### **Day 2: Holocaust Memorial ~ Florida Everglades ~ Miami Beach at Leisure**

This morning we visit the Holocaust Memorial which is dedicated to the memory of the millions who suffered and died at the hands of the Nazis during World War II. Later today we embark on an Eco-Adventure Tour which features a 30-minute airboat ride through the Everglades, followed by an Alligator Wildlife Nature Show. Later this afternoon we return to our hotel and enjoy the balance of the day at leisure. Miami Beach is known worldwide for its sunny days, sandy beaches and lovely palm trees.

### **Day 3: Miami ~ The Keys ~ Key West ~ Conch Train Tour ~ Hemingway Home**

Today we leave the Miami Beach area and travel the Road That Went to the Sea, which ends in Key West. Along the way we pass over Key Largo, Marathon and Big Pine Key. By early afternoon we arrive in the southernmost city in the continental United States, Key West. Blessed with a delightful subtropical climate, Key West is known for its rocky shores, sandy beaches and weathered homes reminiscent of a coastal New England town. Enjoy the next three nights in Key West. Later today we embark from Mallory Square on a guided Conch Train Tour which features Old Town, Ernest Hemingway Home, Duval Street Southernmost Point and the waterfront.

### **Day 4: Key West at Leisure**

Today is yours to enjoy in Key West. Stroll through the shops, boutiques and museums of Old Town. Key West offers a wide selection of optional attractions including a lighthouse and maritime museum, butterfly and nature conservatory, shipwreck historeum and aquarium. Along Duval Street, imaginative cafes and open-air restaurants serve Caribbean cuisine ranging from gourmet specialties to ethnic snacks. Every night ore than two dozen street vendors and performers vie for the attention of spectators gathered at Mallory Square Dock in Old Town.

### **Day 5: Glass-Bottom Boat Cruise ~ Little White House Museum ~ Farewell Dinner**

This morning we depart on a scenic glass-bottom boat cruise out to nearby coral reefs. Twenty windows set at an angle in the hull of an 80-foot vessel provide a panoramic view of the reef and its colorful and exotic sea life. Later this afternoon we visit the Little White House Museum. Built in the 1940's this lovely home served as a vacation retreat for Presidents Harry Truman, Dwight Eisenhower and John F. Kennedy. This evening we gather for a special farewell dinner. Be sure to take advantage of Key West's most popular natural attraction – it's sunsets!

**Day 6: Key West ~ Miami ~ Journey Home:** Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at the hotel before transferring back to Miami for our return flight home.
