



## **SAMPLE ITINEARY ITINERARY OCTOBER 18-21, 2022**

Day 1: Home City ~ Charleston, WV ~ State Capitol Building ~ Capitol Market:

Departures: Eastern Hills Mall 6:30 am Tops West Seneca 7:00 am

Depart by motorcoach for Charleston. Comfort and meal stops will be made periodically as we travel. Upon arrival in Charleston enjoy a guided tour of the beautiful West Virginia State Capitol Building. Later today enjoy free time to explore Capitol Market. This evening we gather for a group dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in the Charleston area.

<u>Day 2: Amtrak's Cardinal</u> ~ New River Gorge ~ White Sulphur Springs ~ Lewisburg: This morning after breakfast we board Amtrak's Cardinal for a delightful train ride to White Sulphur Springs. This all-American rail excursion follows the original B&O line into the Allegheny Mountains, along the scenic New River, and into the picturesque New River Gorge, known as the Grand Canyon of the East. Enjoy spectacular views that can only be seen by train. Travel aboard Amtrak's spacious passenger cars equipped with comfortable reclining coach seats. Highlights along this route include New River Gorge Bridge, Sandstone Falls, Stretchers Neck Tunnel and Hawk's Nest Bridge. Later today we arrive in White Sulphur Springs and are then transferred to nearby Lewisburg for a memorable two-night stay. This afternoon, enjoy local sightseeing and shopping in the quaint town of Lewisburg. Later this evening, gather for dinner at a local restaurant.

<u>Day 3: The Greenbrier ~ Bunker Tour ~ Greenbrier at Leisure:</u> Breakfast is included at our hotel. Enjoy the day at The Greenbrier, a lovely historical resort located in a spectacular mountain setting near the Virginia state border. Enjoy a fascinating tour of the Bunker — a top secret Government Relocation Facility designed to accommodate national leaders in the event of a nuclear war. Constructed underneath The Greenbrier during the Eisenhower administration, the complex maintained its secrecy for over 30 years. The balance of the day is free to enjoy and explore the grounds, shops and various amenities and activities that the resort offers.

<u>Day 4: Lewisburg ~ Tamarack West Virginia ~ Journey Home:</u> Following breakfast we depart Lewisburg and begin our journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Stop in Beckley and experience the nation's first showcase of handcrafts and fine art at Tamarack, the best of West Virginia. More than 2,800 artisans from all fifty-five counties in the state have become part of the Tamarack experience. For over 20 years Tamarack has greeted millions of visitors, offering unique, original, and handmade Appalachian goods. Later today arrive back home.
