## ITINERARY

**Day 1 - Home City ~ Holland, Michigan ~ Windmill Island ~ Dazzle Dinner Show:** Travel aboard a deluxe highway touring motorcoach to Holland, Michigan. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Later this afternoon we arrive in the friendly resort town of Holland, settled by Dutch immigrants in 1847. Holland is a city on the shore of Lake Macatawa. The much-photographed Big Red Lighthouse stands by the channel that connects this lake to Lake Michigan. Enjoy time at Windmill Island which features canals, drawbridges, a miniature Dutch Village and a 1780's operating De Zwaan windmill brought from the Netherlands which produces a fine graham flour. Our visit will feature the annual Tulip Time Festival, recalling Holland's Dutch roots, with millions of tulips blooming all over the city. This evening we enjoy a Dazzle dinner and show. The brilliantly fresh talent from four area high schools bursts onto the stage to present this vibrant medley. Enjoy this grand collection of soloists, show choir and orchestral performances — an astounding variety, all in one show. With over 25 acts, this show is packed with entertainment value for all audiences.

**Day 2 – Holland City Tour ~ Holland's Tulip Time Festival ~ FiddleFire Dinner Show:** This morning we enjoy breakfast at our hotel and then embark on a city tour of Holland. Following the tour enjoy the day at the Tulip Time Festival. The Holland, Michigan area boasts nearly 4.5 million tulips, planted & ready to burst forth in bloom in early spring. The City of Holland plants the colorful tulips in parks, at public attractions, along streets and throughout the downtown area. Tulip Time has been named the "Best Small Town Festival" by Readers Digest, and just this past year, received USA Today's 2016 Best Flower Festival! The festival celebrates Holland's Dutch heritage with eight days of events and special attractions. If you love a parade, Tulip Time has three – we will enjoy the Volksparade. The Dutch Marktplaats serves up plenty of Dutch food and merchandise. Throughout town, you'll have the opportunity to experience traditional Klompen (wooden shoe) dancing, as well as the Art & Craft Fair, Quilt Show, carnival rides, concerts, theatrical shows, trolley tours, and so much more! This evening gather for a delicious meal and entertainment at the FiddleFire Dinner Show. A passion for creating exciting musical arrangements as well as the desire to perform together is the inspiration for the Pannings to form their string band, FiddleFire. This group specializes in a variety of music including classical to driving fiddle tunes. Their diverse instrumentation includes fiddles, guitar, string bass, mandolin, percussion and dancing feet! FiddleFire performs to sell-out crowds at Tulip Time each year.

**Day 3 – Holland at Leisure ~ Veldheer's Tulip Farm ~ Journey Home:** Following breakfast enjoy the morning at leisure in Holland. Later we depart for Veldheer's Tulip Farm. Veldheer's Tulip Farm boasts the planting of five million tulips. Later today we begin our journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically.
