Travel Arrangements made by Wendt Touring

Day 1: Cleveland – Holland Michigan – Dazzle Dinner Show

Travel aboard a deluxe highway touring motorcoach to Holland, Michigan. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Later this afternoon we arrive in the friendly resort town of Holland for a delightful three-night stay. Our visit will feature the annual Tulip Time Festival, recalling Holland's Dutch roots, with Millions of tulips blooming all over the city. Tulip Time has been named the "Best Small-Town Festival" by Readers Digest, and received USA Today's 2016 Best Flower Festival! This evening we gather for dinner at a local restaurant followed by the Dazzle Show. The brilliantly fresh talent from four area high schools burst onto the stage to present this vibrant medley. Enjoy this grand collection of soloists, show choir and orchestral performances — an astounding variety, all in one show. With over 25 acts, this show is packed with entertainment value for all audiences. Overnight in Holland.

Day 2: Holland City Tour – Holland's Tulip Time Festival – FiddleFire

This morning we enjoy breakfast at our hotel and then embark on a Holland guided city tour. Holland is a city steeped in history and tradition. Located on the shore of Lake Macatawa, the much-photographed Big Red Lighthouse stands by the channel that connects to Lake Michigan. Enjoy a stop at the Holland Museum which tells the story of the area. On display are thousands of fascinating historic objects and artwork from the Netherlands dating back to the 1600s. Enjoy reserved seating at the colorful and entertaining Volksparade. The Dutch Marktplaats serves up plenty of Dutch food and merchandise. We'll have the opportunity to experience traditional Klompen (wooden shoe) dancing. This evening we gather for a delicious meal and entertainment at the FiddleFire Dinner Show. A passion for creating exciting musical arrangements as well as the desire to perform together is the inspiration for the Pannings to form their popular string band, FiddleFire. Overnight in Holland.

Day 3: Windmill Island – Veldheer's Tulip Farm – DeKlomp Wooden Shoe & Delft Factory – Meijer Gardens

Following breakfast, enjoy the morning at Windmill Island which features canals, drawbridges, a miniature Dutch Village and a 1780's operating De Zwaan windmill brought from the Netherlands which produces a fine graham flour. Depart for Veldheer's Tulip Farm which boasts the planting of five million tulips. Also, on the grounds is DeKlomp Wooden Shoe & Delft Factory. Later today travel to Grand Rapids and visit the sparkling Frederik Meijer Gardens and Sculpture Park. May is a beautiful month in which to visit. This exquisite park contains perennial, American, Victorian, shade and arid gardens; nature trails; a carnivorous plant house and tropical plants in the five-story Conservatory (Michigan's largest). Overnight in Holland

Day 4: Holland Michigan – Frankenmuth Bavarian Village – Cleveland

Breakfast included. Head to charming Frankenmuth. Here we see School House Square, Glockenspiel Tower and a 19th Century Holz Brucke – Frankenmuth's wooden covered bridge that spans the Cass River. German melodies ring through the streets of Frankenmuth as you enjoy free time to explore on your own. A visit to the Famous Bronner's Christmas Store is also included. Travel back to Ohio for an early evening return home.
