

## ITINERARY

**Day 1: Home ~ Albany, NY:** Travel aboard a deluxe motorcoach across New York State and into the Albany area for the first overnight. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically as we travel. Enjoy dinner and overnight in the Albany area.

**Day 2: Green Mountains ~ Bennington Monument ~ Robert Frost Grave ~ Hildene Estate ~ Green Mountain Railroad ~ White River Junction, VT:** This morning we travel into Vermont for a stop in historic Bennington, located in a lovely valley along the foothills of the Green Mountains. Bennington's three covered bridges and numerous Victorian homes are reminders of times gone by. Visit the gravesite of Robert Frost followed by a stop at Bennington Battle Monument which was the tallest battle monument in the world when completed in 1891. Continue north into the heart of the Green Mountains and visit the historic Hildene Estate, former summer home of Robert Todd Lincoln and his wife Mary Harlan Lincoln. Enjoy ample time to tour the beautiful home, stroll through the lovely gardens and absorb the magnificent mountain vistas. Continue into the heart of Vermont for a beautiful scenic fall train ride aboard the Green Mountain Railroad. From Chester enjoy a scenic one-hour excursion; passing through historic villages, along rivers, through the Green Mountains to Rockingham before returning to Chester. Later today we travel to White River Junction for dinner and a delightful two-night stay.

**Day 3: Montpelier ~ Vermont State House ~ Morse Farms Maple Sugar Works ~ Trapp Family Lodge ~ Ben & Jerry's Ice Cream Factory:** This morning following breakfast we travel to Montpelier to visit the Vermont State House, one of the nation's oldest and best-preserved state capitols. Continue to Morse Farms Maple Sugar Works for a maple demonstration and tasty sampling. Following a lunch break we travel to Stowe and visit the renowned Trapp Family Lodge – a mountain resort in the European tradition by the family that inspired “The Sound of Music.” Enjoy a historical tour followed by free time to stroll the grounds and visit the wonderful gift store. Later today visit Ben and Jerry's Ice Cream Factory. The tour includes demonstrations of each step in the process of making ice cream. Return to our hotel in White River Junction for the night.

**Day 4: Quechee Gorge ~ Woodstock ~ Lake George Cruise ~ Lake George, New York:** This morning we visit Quechee Gorge - the Grand Canyon of Vermont. Hundreds of thousands of visitors stop each year to take in the breathtaking views of the Quechee Gorge. Continue to Woodstock, Vermont. Famous world-wide as the quintessential New England Village, Woodstock has been described as “The Prettiest Small Town in America” by *Ladies Home Journal*. In the downtown area you'll find quaint shops and galleries, up and down staircases, in alleys, and along hidden side streets. Enjoy ample time for shopping and lunch on own in Woodstock. Later today we journey across central Vermont and into the rugged Adirondack Mountains of New York State. An afternoon boat cruise on beautiful Lake George is a lovely introduction to this scenic region. Final overnight in the Lake George area.

**Day 5: Journey Home:** This morning following breakfast we begin our journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically.
