ITINERARY

Day 1: Cleveland ~ Elkins, West Virginia ~ Graceland Inn ~ American Mountain Theater

Travel aboard a deluxe highway touring motorcoach into the beautiful mountain state of West Virginia. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Later today we arrive in the quaint town of Elkins for a memorable three-night stay. Once the railroad-shipping hub for a vast coal, timber and railroad empire, Elkins is now the base for several passenger trains and live musical productions. Visit the campus of Davis & Elkins College for a special welcome dinner at magnificent Graceland Inn. Following dinner, transfer to American Mountain Theater for West Virginia's first "Branson Style" family music, comedy and variety show.

Day 2: Cass Scenic Railroad ~ National Radio Astronomy Observatory

Breakfast included. This morning we travel to the town of Cass. Enjoy the Cass Scenic Railroad aboard a passenger train pulled by one of the old steam Shay locomotives that once hauled logging trains up the steep slopes of Cheat Mountain. The excursion offers awesome mountain vistas to Whittaker Station. Following the train ride, enjoy an interesting slide presentation at the Historical Museum. This afternoon, visit the National Radio Astronomy Observatory which features the world's largest fully steerable radio telescope. Overnight Elkins.

Day 3: The Greenbrier Resort ~ The Bunker ~ Lewisburg

After enjoying breakfast, depart for a delightful drive south to White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia. Visit the Greenbrier, a lovely historical resort located in a spectacular mountain setting near the Virginia state border. Enjoy a fascinating tour of the Bunker – a top secret Government Relocation Facility designed to accommodate national leaders in the event of a nuclear war. Constructed underneath the Greenbrier during the Eisenhower administration, the complex maintained its secrecy for over 30 years. Later, enjoy a delicious luncheon at the Greenbrier Resort. Facilities, service and décor characterize this upscale property. The world-renown grand resorts flamboyant interior design spans a range of eras. This afternoon, enjoy free time at the Greenbrier and stroll the beautiful grounds and visit the quaint shops and boutiques. Later in the day as we make our way back to Elkins, visit the town of Lewisburg known for its American Revolution and Civil War history. Overnight Elkins.

Day 4: Elkins, West Virginia ~ Charleston State Capital Tour ~ Cleveland

Breakfast included. Enjoy stunning autumn fall foliage colors as we travel thru the heart of West Virginia to Charleston. Tour the State Capital Building located on the Kanawha River – an architectural masterpiece. Free time to explore a bit of Charleston on your own. Afterwards, journey home.
